KENNEL POLICY

We suggest that you print this page out for your files

Things you should know about and before boarding your pet with us:

PLEASE NOTE: AS a general rule we do not accept or release dogs before 8am or after 5pm (however this can be decided on a case by case basis should an emergency or special needs mandate).

Payment: Cash or check only (All checks must be made to Miriam Rieck)

You are charged on a calendar stay night ONLY.

Vaccinations cannot come due during your stay with us. All dogs must be on a flea prevention policy.

All weekend stays are a minimum of two nights. (Drop Off Friday, Pick Up on Sunday. Drop off on Saturday-Pick up on Monday)

All non-holiday cancellations must be done 24 hours prior to your arrival. If you are a no show you will be sent an invoice that carries the full charge of your reserved stay.

All Holiday Reservations require a cancellation policy of 48 hours in advance. All Holiday reservations are a minimum of a two night stay.

You are financially responsible for any damage that your pet does to the interior/exterior of his/her kennel and its content



Terms and Conditions

1. BYD KENNEL agrees to exercise reasonable care for the pet delivered by the Owner to Kennel for boarding, and to keep its premises sanitary and properly enclosed. It is expressly agreed by Owner and Kennel that Kennel's liability shall in no event exceed the lesser of the current chattel value of a pet of the same species or the sum of \$200.00 per animal boarded. The Owner further agrees to be solely responsible for any and all acts or behavior of said pet while it is in the care of the Kennel.
2. BYD Kennel does not assume and shall not be held responsible for any liability with respect to the pet listed in this agreement, of any kind whatsoever, arising out of or from the boarding of this pet, or any damages which may accrue from any other cause whatsoever, including loss by fire, theft, disease, running away, death, injury to persons, animals, or property, or death or injury to any other animal caused by the within named pet during the term of this contract.
3. I have received a copy of the Policy Sheet for BYD KENNEL.
4. Owner further agrees that the pet shall not leave the kennel until all charges are paid to Kennel by Owner.
5. If pet(s) becomes ill or if the state of the animal's health otherwise requires professional attention, the Kennel, in its sole discretion, may engage the services of a veterinarian or administer medicine or give other requisite attention to the animal, and the expenses thereof shall be paid by the Owner.
6. All charges incurred by Owner shall be payable upon pick-up of pet.
7. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this contract, or the breach thereof, or as the result of any claim or controversy involving the alleged negligence by any party to this contract, shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association, and judgment upon the award rendered by an arbitrator may be entered in any Court having jurisdiction thereof. The arbitrator shall, as part of his award, determine an award to the prevailing party of the costs of such arbitration and reasonable attorney's fees of the prevailing party.
